
This matter comes before the Iowa Public Information Board (IPIB) this 17th day of December, 2015, to consider the probable cause report filed on December 9, 2015.

Upon review of the probable cause report and its findings and recommendations, the IPIB finds there is no probable cause to believe that a violation of Iowa Code section 22.7(4) or 22.7(11) has occurred.

The IPIB does find that the Respondent should have acknowledged the initial record request in a timelier manner.

Therefore, the IPIB approves the recommendations of the probable cause report and orders that this complaint is dismissed. The IPIB further orders that the Respondent is formally warned to avoid future delays when acknowledging record requests.
